

David Hartl, keyboards, is known as a master of many styles and instruments. His career has included performances on piano and synthesizer with hundreds of popular artists including Joni Mitchell, Aretha Franklin, Smokey Robinson, Peabo Bryson, Andrea Bocelli, Il Divo, The Three Degrees, The Supremes, and many more; over two decades on the faculty of the University of the Arts; over 60 musical theater productions; jazz performances with artists including Jimmy Bruno, Phil Woods, Don Menza, Joanne Brackeen, and many others; thousands of performances on piano, synthesizers, accordion, guitar, and Chapman Stick; and the composition and production of five original albums.

He is currently co-leading the jazz funk band Musical Collusion with saxophonist Carl Cox; playing with singer Paula Johns as musical director for her Tribute to Dionne Warwick and Burt Bacharach show; playing with The Ronstadt Revue, the ultimate Linda Ronstadt tribute band; arranging and playing accordion with the Divine Hand Ensemble; and playing solo piano in many venues (and sneaking Frank Zappa tunes in whenever he can). He is also working on an album of solo piano realizations of Frank Zappa's compositions.
